Math:

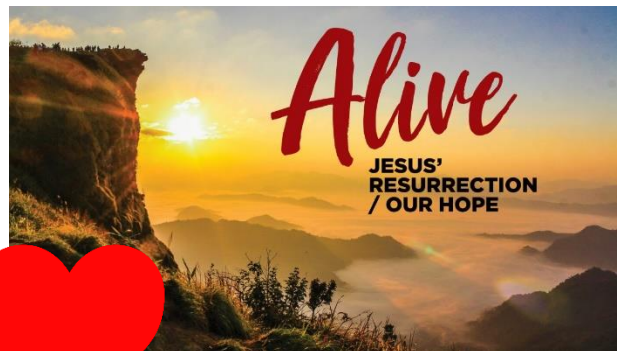
