BIBLE LESSON

This week, we will be studying the effect of Sin on the World. We will read from passages of Genesis 6-9 which tells the account of a worldwide flood and a man named Noah. This account teaches us that because God is holy, He cannot tolerate sin; but because He is loving and faithful, He saves His people. To put it at a more kindergarten level, Sin makes God sad and angry, but God loves and forgives His faithful children.

READING

It's time! We will now start to study letters and sounds together. Our pace is about 2 letters per week. This week, we will focus on the letter a and the short a sound heard in apple. We will learn about the letter m. As we learn more letters and the sounds associated with them, we will begin to put together words and start to read! In a few weeks, you will receive a digital copy of a decodable reader that we will work on reading at school, but to really help your child, plan to read it at home as well. :)

This week, our themes will be animals and maps. We will read Animal Babies, A House for a Hermit Crab, Mapping Sam and Me on the Map. In addition to reading the sound of these letters, we will be practicing writing upper and lower case M's and A's. You can support this skill at home by referencing the letter formation guide that was recently sent home in the homework folder.

MATH

We are finishing up our first chapter in math, classifying and sorting. This week our focus will be to make sure we are all solid in these concepts and begin Chapter 2, patterns!
